In 1955, The Sapulpa Brick & Tile team won the National Softball Congress World Championship by beating out every team west of the Mississippi. The magnificent, 3-feet-tall trophy resides at the Sapulpa Historical Society Museum. Dude Ausmus was the leading hitter in the NSC that year, batting .563. He was the leading hitter again in 1961 for the World Champion Dautrich Realty team from El Paso, TX, batting .500. He was named to six All World teams between 1955 and 1962.
