Jack Grafmeier was an avid fast-pitch softball fan and player. Jack was instrumental in getting the ISC World Tournament to Kimberly, WI and was the tournament director for the first five tournaments. He remained on as a Commissioner and world tournament advisor for the ISC for 22 years, from 1972 through 1995. He was instrumental in getting the ISC Hall of Fame to Kimberly and was the Curator. He was inducted into the Hall of Fame in 1985. The KRA honored him with a plaque in the press box at Sunset Park as 'The House That Jack Built'. An annual tournament named in his honour continues to be played each June.
