

Ken Wycoff, El Paso, TX



There was a boom in softball in El Paso, TX following World War II and one of the best in the game at the time was Ken Wycoff, a crafty pitcher who could cut down batters with eerily bewildering pitches. He served in the U.S. Air Force from 1946 to 1975 and rose to the rank of Chief Master Sergeant and was nominated as the First Sergeant of the Air Force. In the 1960's he was a renowned fast pitch softball pitcher and was inducted into the softball hall of fame in 1989. Stationed at Biggs Field, he joined Dautrich Realty in 1960 and won two ISC titles in 1961 and 1962, pitching a one-hitter in the championship in 1961, while going 3-0 and being named as the Most Outstanding Pitcher in 1962.
